- Set up a Hutt Street Tips Jar wherever your community meets – donate whenever good luck comes your way. Share your joy with someone whose luck is down at the moment.
- Sell Hutt Street Calendars within your community in November and December.
- Organise an auction of community donations with proceeds going to Hutt Street Centre.
- When you hold your own fund-raising events, consider making a small gift to Hutt Street at the same time.
- Encourage talented people within your community to volunteer at Hutt Street either as individuals or small groups.
- Remember Hutt Street Centre at Easter and Christmas. Small gifts to individuals with notes from the giver are always appreciated.
- Invite a staff member from Hutt Street Centre to visit your community to talk about the centre and answer your questions about those how rely on the Centre and the nature of support available to those who visit.
- Coordinate a Welcome Home package for a family or a single person who finally is provided with secure housing: a heater, pillows, kettle, blankets, pyjamas, cleaning products, a dining table and chairs and whatever it is you believe are the essential items we all need day-to-day. Imagine what a difference your community might make.
